

Burning Code Residential

Residential:

1. Open burning shall not be less than 50 feet any structure (IFC 307.4)

Exceptions: 1. Fires in approved containers that are not less 15 feet from structure.

2. The minimum required distance from a structure shall be 25 feet where the pile size is 3 feet or less in diameter and 2 feet or less in height.

2. Bonfires shall not be conducted within 50 feet of a structure or combustible material unless the fire is contained in a barbecue pit. (IFC 307.4.1) A permit is needed for bonfires.

3. Recreational fires shall not be conducted within 25 feet of a structure or combustible material. (IFC 307.4.2)

4. Piles shall not exceed one hundred twenty-five (125) cubic feet (5ft. x 5ft. x 5ft.)

5. No burning will be allowed when winds are in excess of fifteen (15) miles per hour.

6. Burning shall take place only between the hours of 7:00am and 5:00pm.

7. No burning will be allowed on any City or County street, road or alley.

8. Attendance of open burning, bonfires or recreational fires shall be constantly attended until the fire is extinguished. A minimum of one portable fire extinguisher complying with Section 906 (IFC) with a minimum 4-A rating or other approved on - site fire - extinguishing equipment, such as dirt, sand, water barrel, garden hose or water truck shall be available for immediate utilization. (IFC 307.5)
