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If accepted, I \_\_\_\_\_ agree to follow the guidelines listed below, and I accept the following responsibilities. I understand that this signed declaration is required in order for me to be a participant in the Legacy Gardens at either of the locations.

1. I accept full responsibility for the maintenance of my individual garden plots, and I accept shared responsibility for the maintenance of common areas and furnishings that are provided by other Gardeners and the Legacy Garden provider. This includes leaving water as you found it when you arrived and remove all trash or put in receptacles.
2. I will attend a pre-season organizational meeting if at all possible and commit to helping with a Oct. or Nov. cleanup day
3. As a community gardener I understand the importance of helping with the garden upkeep and improvement. I will follow watering guide lines as defined by the Garden Coordinator.
4. I understand that there will be no charge for the use of the plots or the water and there will be one each 4'X4' plot provided with the opportunity of having more, if indicated above and extra plots are available at the time of planting and the garden coordinator determines there are going to be unused plots.
5. The terms of this contract will begin on April 1<sup>st</sup>. and end on Nov. 1<sup>st</sup> and if I am in good standing with the garden committee, the contract may be renewed annually.
6. I will not expand my plot beyond the measurements indicated or into paths, and other plots, I will not allow my plants to grow more than 6 ft. tall. I must keep my plot free of weeds, pests, and diseases by only using all natural products that are friendly to bees and butterflies. Flower and herb planting is encouraged. I will consult with the Garden Coordinator before using any products to control weeds, pests, and /or diseases.
7. I will not plant any illegal plants. I will not smoke, drink alcoholic beverages, or use illegal drugs around the church or City Hall property. I will not bring weapons, pets or other animals to the garden.
8. I can keep all items that are produced to be used, sold or given away as I desire.

9. I understand and agree that St. Andrew Community Gardens is not responsible for any damage or loss due to wildlife. I will "Hold Harmless" St. Andrew or any person or group involved with the Community Gardens due to anything that arises during this contract.
10. I will notify the Garden Coordinator if I cannot care for my plot, during periods of absence, I will make arrangements for my plot to be watered and maintained. I understand that if my plot appears to the Coordinator to be neglected or abandoned and the situation is not corrected, I will be emailed and/or given a phone notice by the garden coordinator and my plot may be forfeited. If I do not have email or a phone, only one written notice will be mailed to me before I forfeit any and all of my plots.
11. Guests and visitors, including children, may enter the garden only if I accompany them. They must follow all rules, terms and conditions stated here in. I will supervise my children at all times when they are in the garden area.
12. I will not take food or plants from other gardeners' plots. I will not take anything from the garden that is not rightfully mine.
13. I will respect other gardeners and will not use abusive or profane language or discriminate against others.
14. I will work to keep the garden a secure and enjoyable place where all participants can garden and socialize peacefully in a neighborly manner.
15. The St. Andrew Legacy Gardens is not responsible for personal injury or property damage incurred by any plot user, or for theft, loss, or destruction of any property owned by any plot user.
16. In the event that a dispute arises, between gardeners and/or gardeners and it's organizational leadership, I agree that the Garden Coordinator and the garden committee from the St. Andrew Legacy Gardens will act as the arbiter and that its decision will be final, and binding on all parties.
