

Burning Code Commercial

Commercial:

1. Any one clearing and burning land for a subdivision or land for commercial use.
2. A special permit for burning of trees, brush, clearing waste, and untreated sawn wood is required when it can be shown that burning is the only possible feasible method of disposal and when permitted by the Fire Official. Written permission from the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) shall be required. (<http://www.dnr.mo.gov/>)

Permit conditions and requirements:

1. All permits shall be requested by and issued to the person(s) in legal control of the parcel of the land which burning is to be done.
2. Location of the burn pile shall be at least six hundred (600) feet from any building or structure.
3. An area of at least one hundred (100) feet surrounding the burn pile shall be clear of any combustible matter.
4. All burning shall take place only between the hours of 7:00am and 5:00pm unless otherwise approved by the Fire Official or his/her designation.
5. No burning will be allowed when winds are in excess of fifteen (15) miles per hour.
6. Manned fire control/extinguishment shall be on scene and immediately available.
7. Fires shall not be left unattended until fire is completely extinguished.
8. Air curtain destructor shall be used.
9. A permit fee is required to fire department (\$50.00)
